VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT TO RESIGN FROM JUDICIAL OFFICE IN LIEU OF DISCIPLINARY ACTION

This Agreement is being entered into by the undersigned parties pursuant to Section 33.032(h) of the Texas Government Code.

WHEREAS at all relevant times, the Honorable Wilfred Krause ("Judge Krause") was a Justice of the Peace, Precinct 2, in Industry, Austin County, Texas; and

WHEREAS on or about December 18, 2023, the Commission received a complaint from a Confidential Complainant concerning Judge Krause's non-performance of his judicial duties; and

WHEREAS no Findings of Fact or Conclusions of Law have been made in connection with the above-referenced matters; and

WHEREAS no prior disciplinary action has been taken against Judge Krause, who has not responded to any inquiries by the Commission regarding this complaint, and

WHEREAS the parties agree that the allegations of judicial misconduct, if found to be true, could result in disciplinary action against Judge Krause; and

WHEREAS the parties to this Agreement are desirous of resolving this matter without the time and expense of further disciplinary proceedings.

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED that Judge Krause, upon the signing of this Agreement, officially and formally resigns any and all judicial duties effective immediately and is entering into this Agreement to resolve the above-referenced complaint in lieu of disciplinary action by the Commission, pursuant to Section 33.032(h) of the Texas Government Code. The Commission agrees that it shall pursue no further disciplinary proceedings against Judge Krause in connection with the above-referenced matter.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that Judge Krause, by his execution of this voluntary agreement, does not admit guilt, fault, or liability regarding the matters contained in the complaints referenced above.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that, upon the Commission's approval of this Agreement, Judge Krause shall be forever disqualified from judicial service in the State of Texas, including (a) sitting or serving as a judge, (b) standing for election or appointment to a judicial office, and/or (c) performing or exercising any judicial duties or functions of a judicial officer, including but not limited to the performance of wedding ceremonies.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that any violation of this Agreement by Judge Krause would constitute willful or persistent conduct that is clearly inconsistent with the proper performance of his duties or casts public discredit upon the judiciary or administration of justice in violation of Art. V, Sec. 1-a(6)A of the Texas Constitution, and Section 33.001(b) of the Texas Government Code.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that this Agreement shall be made public as a voluntary agreement to resign from judicial office, pursuant to Section 33.032(h) of the Texas Government Code, and the Commission may enforce this Agreement through any legal process necessary, including injunctive relief; that Travis County, Texas, shall be the proper venue for any dispute between the parties or proceeding relating to this Agreement; and that Judge Krause, individually, shall bear the expense, cost, and any reasonable and necessary attorneys' fees in the event any dispute arising under this Agreement is decided against his by any court or tribunal.

AGREED TO AND ACCEPTED upon its execution by the parties.
